

About the Herbal Fair

International Herbal Fair is an annual feature of Bhopal for over a decade now. Conceptualized as an annual National event, the fair became International from 2011 onwards. The mandate at the inception of the fair was to create a platform for bringing together various stakeholders across the value chain of Minor Forest Produce (MFP) diversity and showcasing the MFP potential of India and its neighbouring countries. The objective of the fair is to provide an environment to enhance marketing opportunities, and forge backward-forward linkages by bringing together MFP collectors, traders, and manufacturers, involved in the processing of MFPs. The fair provides a platform for knowledge sharing, information dissemination and increasing awareness of MFPs by enabling interactions with the practitioners, academia, Institutions, and civil society working in this field. This year the 9th International Herbal Fair will be organized from 20th to 26th December 2022 at Lal Parade Ground, Jahangirabad, Bhopal.

Organizers

The event is jointly organised by the Madhya Pradesh Forest Department and Madhya Pradesh State Minor Forest Produce (Trade & Development) Co-operative Federation. Ltd. The lead organiser, MP MFP Federation is an apex level agency with a membership of over 4 million MFP collectors largely dependent on forest produce for their livelihood. The federation is also an active promoter of the collection, trade and development of MFP including Medicinal and Aromatic Plants (MAPs)
